

# CAUTION:

**THIS FORM WILL NOT WORK IF YOU HAVE OLD ACROBAT SOFTWARE. You must have version 5 or above.**

There are two Adobe products which can read PDF files:

1. The Adobe Acrobat Reader is free and doesn't allow you to save your form once you fill out your details.
2. The Adobe Acrobat program is the full version which allows you to save changes you make when you fill out these forms.

Thus, you could be in 3 different scenarios:

A) If you are using Acrobat Reader (which is available for free) :

You must fill out the form, take a print out of the file and send it by snail mail.

B) If you are using Adobe Acrobat (which is not free) AND you have configured an email client like Outlook or Eudora:

You can fill out the form and hit the "submit form by email client" button, which will launch your default email program, and compose an email on your behalf.

C) If you are using Adobe Acrobat (which is not free) BUT you have never used Outlook, or Eudora:

You can fill out the form and save the form after you have filled it. You can then send the form as an email attachment to [grading@uga.edu](mailto:grading@uga.edu)

If you are applying for an assistantship, this list must reach the department no later than January 1 to assure your consideration for financial support for fall semester; for all others, see the admission application deadlines.
