Course Description:

Students will learn to read and translate Attic Greek. We will cover all of *Athenaze I* this semester.

Athenaze, Book I. Second Edition.
Athenaze, Workbook I. Second Edition.

We will have frequent short quizzes (2-4 per week) to help you keep up with and memorize material from each chapter. No make-up quizzes will be given under any circumstances. The three lowest quiz grades will be dropped. There will be three exams over the course of the semester (after chapters 5, 9 and 13). Make-up exams will only be given with a valid, excused absence from class. Daily preparation and participation in class is extremely important for learning Greek. The Class Participation grade will take into account attendance, preparation of reading and homework assignments and translation in class. Unexcused absences will negatively affect your grade; excessive absences will result in a "0" for your class participation grade. If you are absent from class, it is your responsibility to make sure that I receive any homework collected in class that day.
