**Course Description:**

Students will learn to read and translate Attic Greek. We will cover all of *Athenaze II* this semester, about one chapter per week.

**Required Text:**

*Athenaze, Book II*

**Grading:**

We will have frequent short quizzes (1-2 per week). No make-up quizzes will be given. The two lowest quiz grades will be dropped. There will be four exams over the course of the semester (after chapters 19, 22, 25, 28). Make-up exams will only be given with a valid, excused absence from class. Daily preparation and participation in class is extremely important for learning Greek. The Class Participation grade will take into account attendance, preparation of reading and homework assignments, translation in class. Unexcused absences will negatively affect your grade; excessive absences will result in a "0" for your class participation grade.
