SCHEDULE OF ASSIGNMENT: Fall Semester, 2009

The course syllabus is a general plan for the course; deviations announced to the class by the instructor may be necessary.

We will devote either two or three days to each chapter of Wheelock, depending on the amount of new material it contains.

On the **first day** do this:

- *Study the new grammar by outlining and taking notes on the chapter
- *Memorize the new grammar, especially the paradigms
- *Memorize the new vocabulary in preparation for a vocabulary quiz
- *Practice the grammar and vocabulary by *writing out* the assigned translations
- *Translate the first two *practice & Review* sentences into Latin

For the **second day**:

- *Review grammar and vocabulary
- *Have the new grammatical paradigms memorized in preparation for a quiz.
- *Write out the translations of the assigned sentences and/or passage(s) from Wheelock
- *Write out translations of the remaining *Practice and Review* sentences into Latin

On the **third day**

- *Review grammar and vocabulary
- *Be prepared again for another quiz on vocabulary or grammar
- *Write out the translations of the assigned passage(s) from Wheelock and/or Groton and May.

A more specific list of assignments and quizzes will be distributed every other week.
